Dear Michel,

Thank you for your email below and what we can answer now is as follows:

1. Social Bringing-up Fee varies from province to province, and it even may vary within one province.
2. According to Chinese law, the parents violating law to give birth to more children will be required to pay Social Bring-up Fee and may also have to bear other liabilities. However, no law says they will be put into jail for that reason.
3. Children themselves shall not be punished in any way according to Chinese law. However, further research is required to answer the question whether or not the children may be wrongly treated in practice, which is really a complicated question.

We will do further research if you need a more detailed answer to the questions. Our quotation is for that. Please let us know if we shall go ahead.

For your information, in China we have public holidays from 1 May to 7 May, so we cannot response to you during that peroid.
